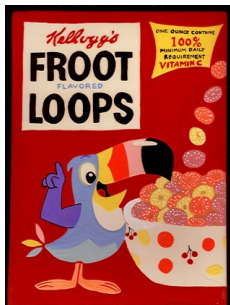
Weekly Church Finances

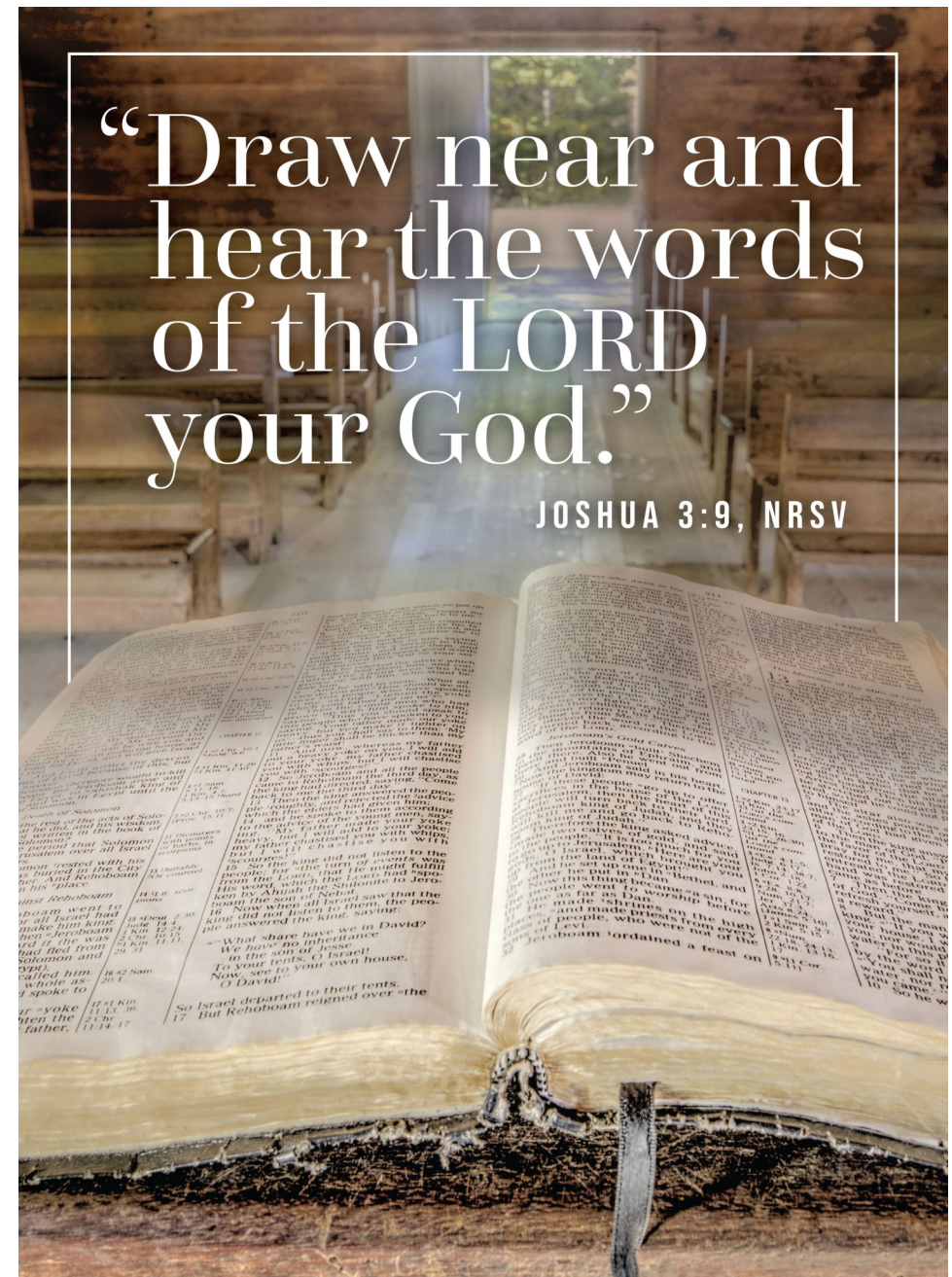
