#### The Angels' Song in Three Words

On the very first Christmas Eve, frightened shepherds were suddenly surrounded by light and music. A choir of angels filled the night sky, singing: "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men" (Luke 2:14, KJV).

Nineteenth-century pastor Charles Kingsley reflected on how those three simple words — glory, peace, and good will — still capture the meaning of Jesus' birth and the hope it brings.

Glory. God's glory isn't shown in dazzling displays of power but in humility and mercy. The baby in the manger revealed God's greatness by stooping low, forgiving, and showing love.

Peace. True peace is more than the absence of conflict. It comes when we follow God's example of selflessness, giving up pride and selfish ambition to live in harmony with one another.

Good will. God's good will toward us is a gift that transforms our lives. Through Jesus, God invites us out of selfishness and sin into a life marked by love, kindness, and community. The angels' song wasn't meant only for shepherds long ago. It still sings to us today, calling each of us to live in glory, peace, and good will.



#### **Bad or Good?**

Everyone has memories of their Christmas traditions. Some involve the tree or how and when presents are opened or a special meal that gets made every year. One habit I've heard of that is used often is the "Santa List".

Parents will tell their children as Christmas gets closer, that they better be good or stop being bad, or Santa will put them on the naughty or bad list and they won't get their presents. Such a threat is serious business to a child at Christmas. They'll try to stay on Santa's good list, at least until Christmas is over.

For Christians, Christmas is a time of celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ, our long-awaited Savior and Redeemer. People waited thousands of years for His coming. He is our rescuer, the one who saved us. Our God incarnate. It is good that we celebrate His coming every year, because we just couldn't stay good, no matter how we tried.

We are all sinners by our very nature. Since Adam and Eve, we have been on God's naughty list. We couldn't follow the rules even when we were warned to be good or face the consequences, just like the mother instructing her child about Santas's list.

We are blessed that Jesus saved us. By His grace and sacrifice we have been taken off the bad list and made good in God's eyes. For this we will receive the ultimate present, an everlasting home with Him in Paradise.


